



## USING THIS GUIDE

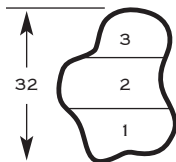
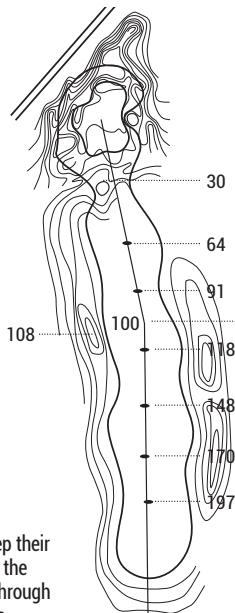
- All distances are measured to the centre of the green
- To determine distances to the pin, calculate the distance to the middle and then add or subtract yardage depending on the day's pin placement using the green enlargement diagram.
- Distance to various hazards off the tee on par-4 and par-5 holes are shown with the corresponding tee deck (numbered 1 to 4). Additional distances are provided for hazards and bunkers. Use these distances to calculate carry or lay-up yardages.
- Distances on the par-3 holes are measured from the black tee marker. To determine the distance from your corresponding tee, simply subtract the difference marked in the yardage guide.
- Sprinkler heads on the golf course are marked and noted in this yardage guide.
- Tarandowah is a very difficult golf course. Tee boxes have been positioned accordingly to accommodate all skill levels of golfer. For your enjoyment we strongly recommend the following:

Black Tees -	0 to 5 handicap
Gold Tees -	5 to 8 handicap
Blue Tees -	8 to 18 handicap
White/Red Tees -	18+ handicap

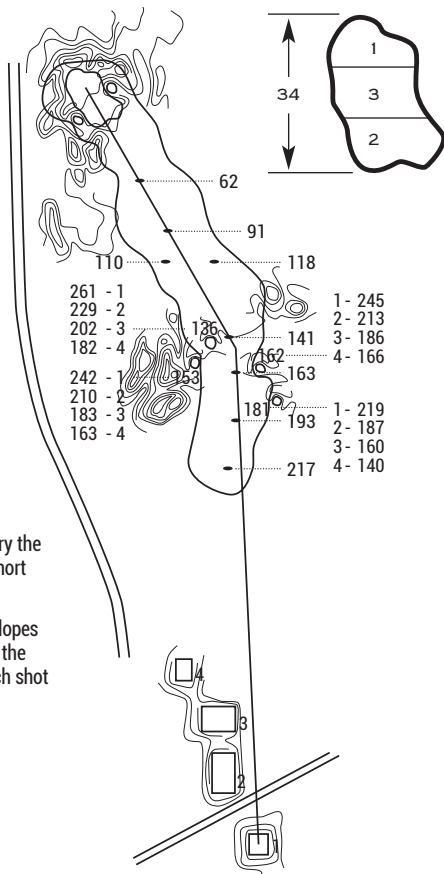
Longer hitters need to keep their tee shot to the left side of the fairway to avoid running through the fairway into the fescue.

On your approach, avoid going long as the collection area falls steeply away towards the hazard.

A solid tee shot can carry the left bunkers leaving a short approach.

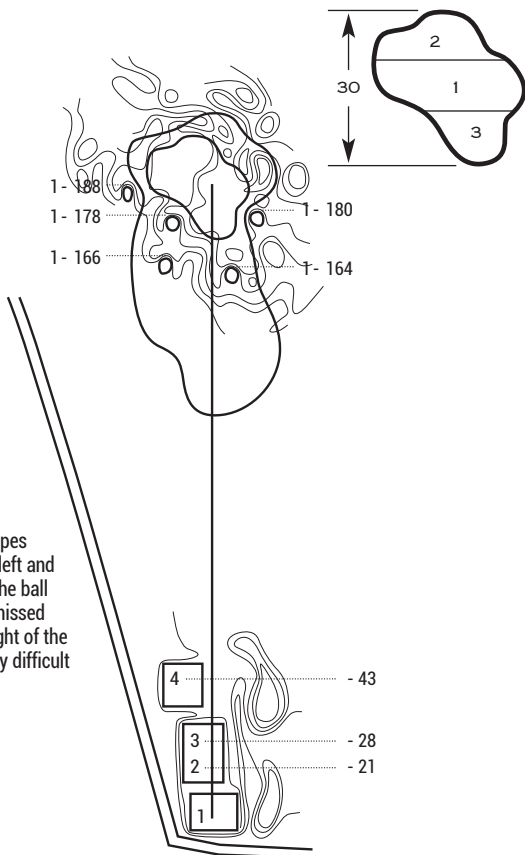
The front of the green slopes away, so if the pin is on the front, land your approach shot just short of the green.

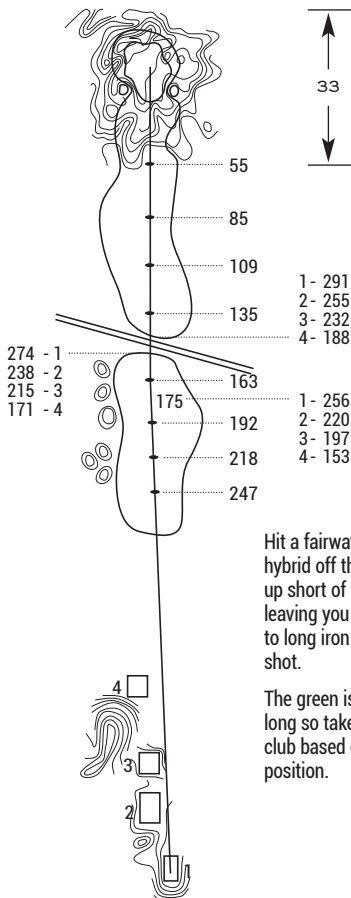

Hit a fairway wood or hybrid off the tee to lay up short of the burn leaving you with a mid to long iron approach shot.

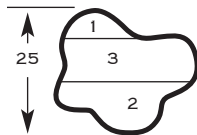
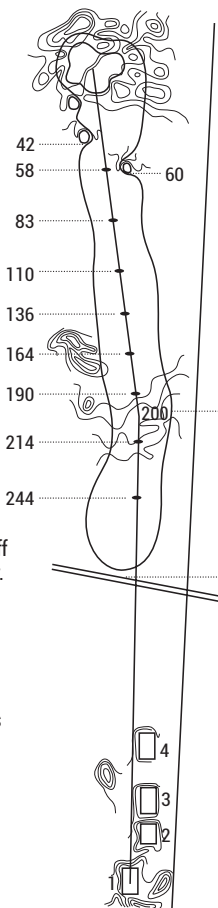
The green is deceptively long so take the right club based on the pin position.

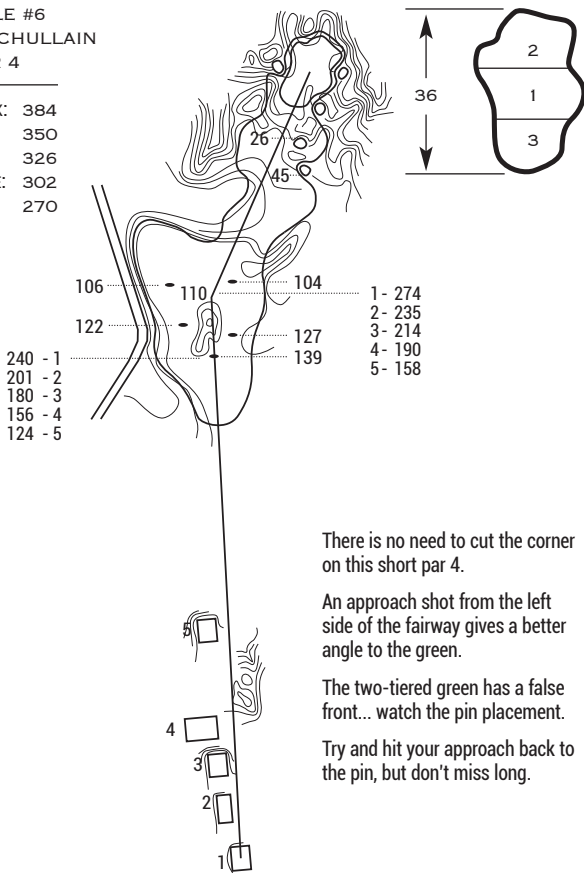

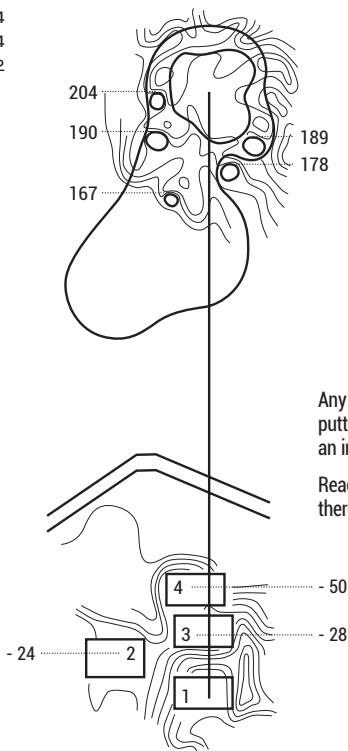
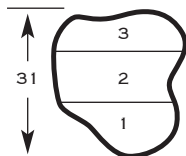
An approach shot from the left side of the fairway gives a better angle to the green.

The two-tiered green has a false front... watch the pin placement.

Try and hit your approach back to the pin, but don't miss long.

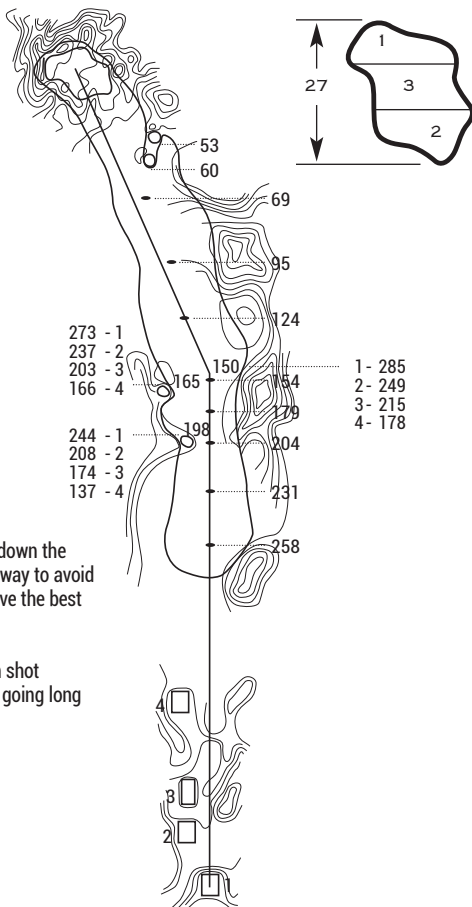
Read the green well as there are many slopes.

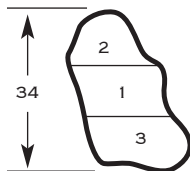
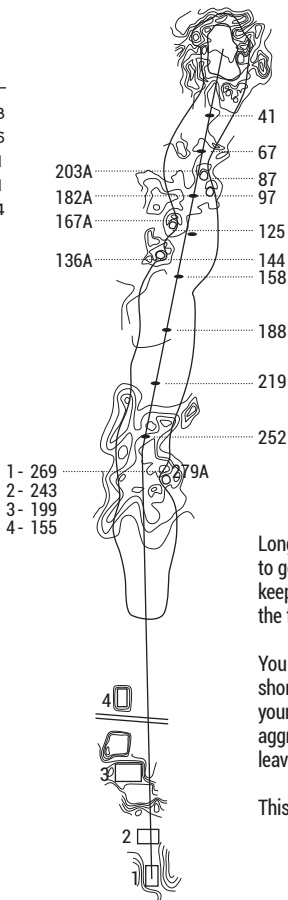


Keep your tee shot down the right side of the fairway to avoid the bunkers and leave the best approach angle.

Keep your approach shot short of the hole as going long is deadly.

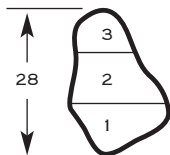
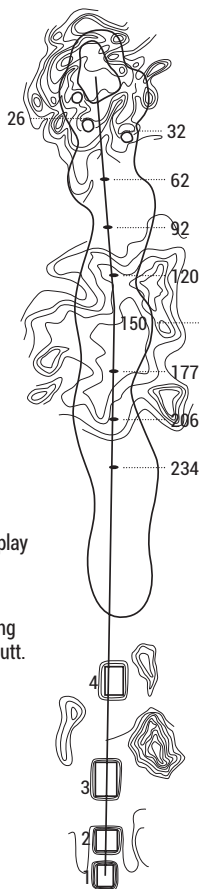
Long hitters will have a chance to go for the green in two, but keep your tee shot left to avoid the fairway bunker.

You have to decide to either lay up short of the four bunkers and leave yourself a longer approach, or be aggressive and try to carry them leaving only a short wedge in.

This green is longer than it looks.

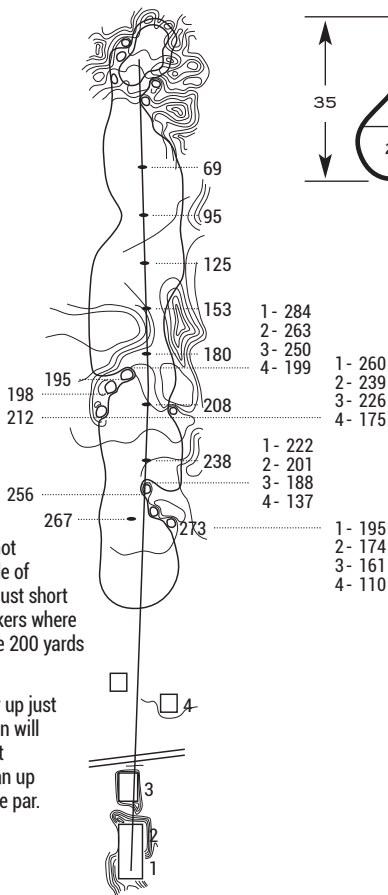

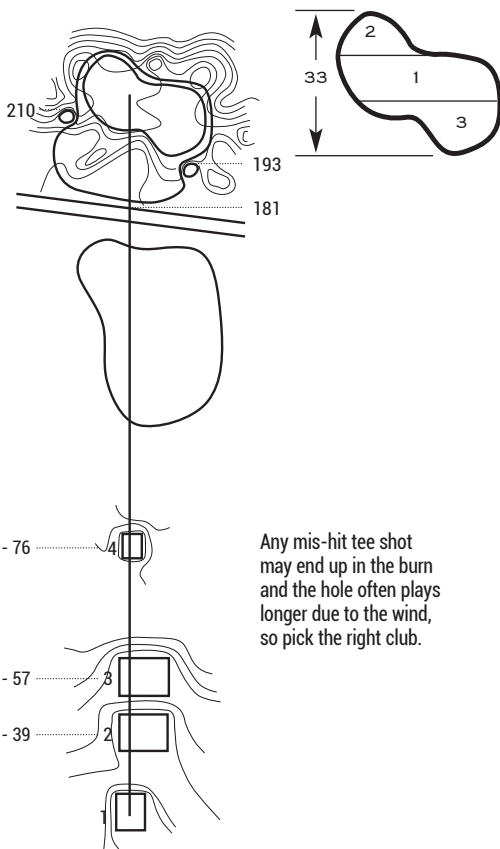


Keep your tee shot down the left side of the fairway and just short of the three bunkers where you will still have 200 yards or more to go.

Sometimes a lay up just short of the green will give you the best opportunity for an up and down to save par.

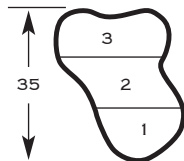
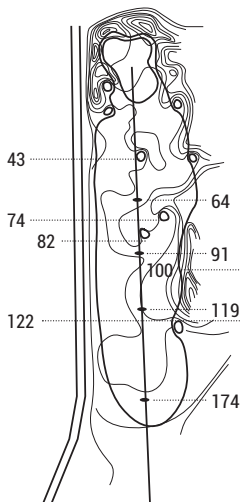

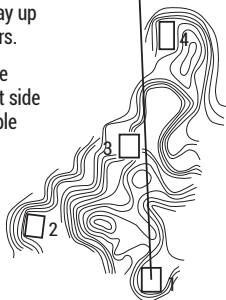

When approaching the green, favour the right side as there is more trouble left than right.

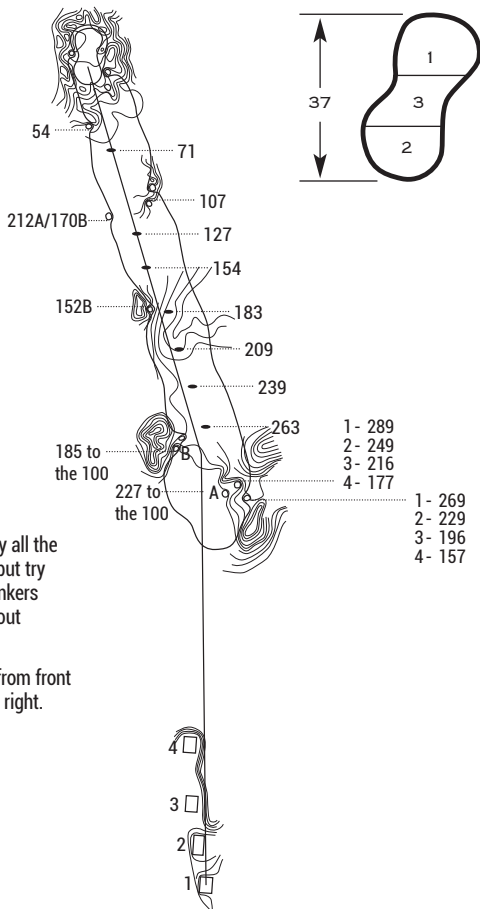

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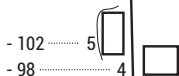
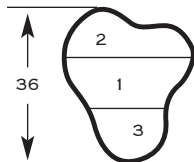
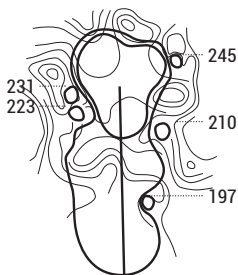
A generous fairway all the way to the green, but try to avoid all the bunkers scattered throughout the hole.

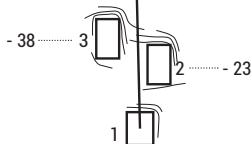

The green is bigger than it looks from the tee and the back half slopes away.

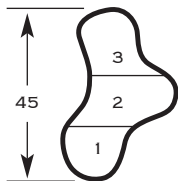
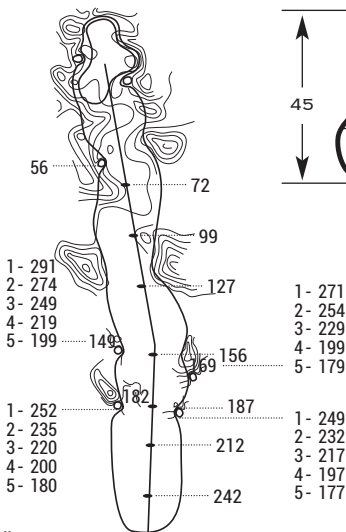
Missing the green left will leave a difficult up and down.





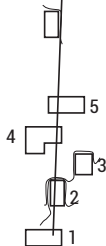

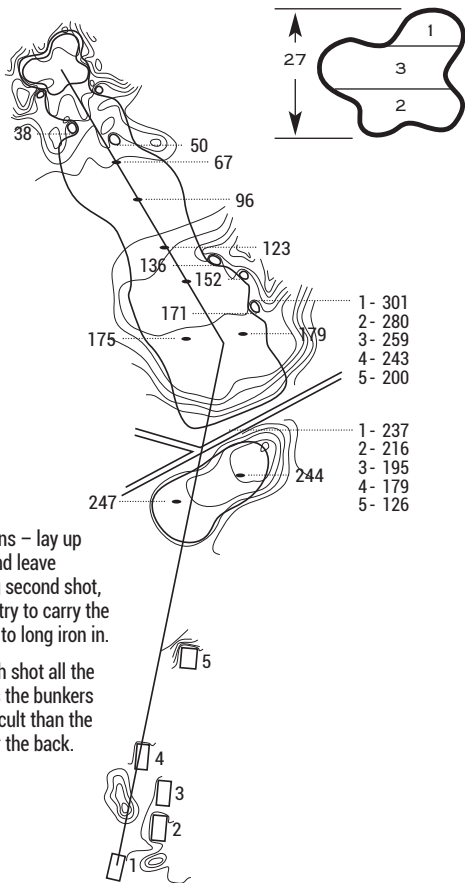
Your tee shot must split the bunkers or you can chalk up a bogey or worse.

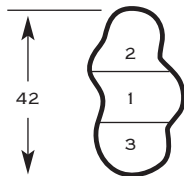
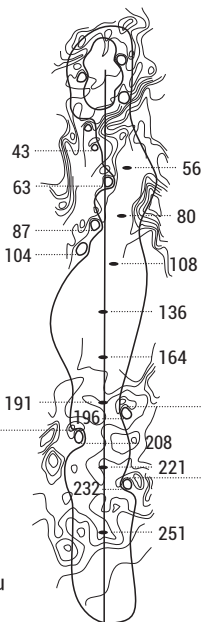


You have two options – lay up short of the burn and leave yourself a very long second shot, or swing away and try to carry the burn, leaving a mid to long iron in.

Carry your approach shot all the way to the green as the bunkers short are more difficult than the collection area over the back.
